## Privacy by Design: An Oxymoron, An Impossibility or The Way To Go?

A number of recent initiatives in identity management in Australia have included Privacy by Design as part of more comprehensive strategies to respect privacy. These include the health identifier soon to be issued for all Australians. Globally, the phenomenon of Social Networks has pushed the notion of Privacy norms. But is this really a panacea? **Malcolm Crompton** will give his perspective on these developments. He will also give his perspective on the wider question of how individuals can be assured that personal information about them is under control and where they are uncertain or want to do so, exercise control themselves.



*Malcolm Crompton is Managing Director of Information Integrity Solutions P/L. He was Australia's Privacy Commissioner for five years until April 2004. He led the implementation of Australia's private sector privacy law. He is also the Asia Pacific based Director of the International Association of Privacy Professionals (IAPP). He was the Foundation President of the Australia New Zealand affiliate of IAPP. He has advised Australian Government departments and agencies, Australian financial services institutions and many leading global ICT companies on developing trust and delivering privacy to customers. Malcolm has advised APEC on the APEC privacy framework. He is also a member of the Microsoft Trustworthy Computing Academic Advisory Board, the global External Advisory Board of the IBM Privacy Institute, the Reference Group for the PrimeLife project and has sat on international privacy award judging panels. In the previous 20 years, Malcolm held senior executive positions in the Australian Public Service. He has degrees in Chemistry and Economics.*
